Site Description

The Vending at the ArtsWells Festival takes place in front of and beside the community hall. This location is between the Hall and the other evening stage (acoustic church). No dogs allowed on site.

Time Line

The main vending days are Saturday and Sunday but you are welcome to be open throughout the entire festival. The festival opens on Friday at 6pm and closes on Monday at 6pm. In the mornings most events/venues don't start till noon with a few things happening as early as 10am. In the evenings people disperse by 2:30am. During the day (Noon to 8pm) there are many venues including in the hall and church. These are the evening stages (8pm to 2am) and are on either side of vendor area. The local stores and restaurants will be closed by 9pm.

Your Space

We provide only an area which is on pavement or sloped hard-pack dry ground. Vendors are responsible for bringing tents and tables. Please indicate the space required of your set up so that we can plan out our limited vendor spaces (ie 10'x10' tent, 8'x5' for table and chair, or 12'x12' area). Only a couple of the spaces can have a vehicle parked behind them. Loading-and-unloading-stopping is permitted on the pavement and weekend parking is within half a block of the vendor area.

Cost Information

Vendors will pay \$75 and receive a weekend pass and a 12' x 12' space. Parking at the vendor space, power and water must be arranged ahead of time and an additional fee will be charged.

Screening of Goods

Due to the local Merchants of Wells, we require Vendors to provide a detailed list of items sold.

Accommodation

Wells has several campgrounds and hotels. For vendors it is also possible to camp at a nearby site for an extra charge of \$10 a night per person. This camping area is a luxury provided by the City for Performers, Volunteers, and Vendors. Any loud campers will be immediately evicted, no refunds.

Mountain Weather

Weather-wise, it's a good idea to be ready for anything. Its not unusual here to go from a bright, sunny, summer day to a torrential downpour, possibly followed by hail or snow and then back to 25°C and sunshine all within an hour. It does get cold at night so please bring warm clothes and sleeping gear if you are planning on tenting.

Checking In and Setting Up

When you arrive in Wells you need to check in at the main box office located at the IMA Gallery during gallery hours (10am to 6pm), and at the Community Hall Main stage in the evening (6pm to 2am). You can check in and begin setting up as early as Friday morning.
